Please note that students under disciplinary action or those who commit Honor Code violations may lose these privileges for the period of time commensurate with the recommendation of the Disciplinary Committee or Honor Council.

## THE HUN SCHOOL OF PRINCETON **Permission Form to Leave Campus**

Beginning Monday, October 28, 2019 seniors and PG's will be given permission to leave campus for lunch granted that they abide by all of the following criteria:

- You do not have any grades lower than 70 in the first marking period.
- You must have more than 50 minutes free.
- The Offices of the Dean of Students must have a **signed permission form** on file from your parents.
- You must sign out, and back in, with the Office of the Dean of Students.
- You adhere to the **New Jersey and Pennsylvania Department of Transportation regulations** regarding transporting passengers. 17 year old New Jersey drivers are **not permitted to have more than one person in the car with them,** other than their family members. The regulation is that once a student has turned 18, he or she may transport as many passengers as there are seat belts. This same regulation applies to Pennsylvania drivers.
- Your privileges will be revoked or suspended if you do not return to campus on time or fail to follow the above procedures.
